It was decided that this car should be given the best quality renovation so work began with the car being completely dismantled and the interior being removed as well. The leather seats that brought Sir Winston Churchill and other illustrious personalities were conserved and the leather was cleaned and given treatment to preserve its quality and life.



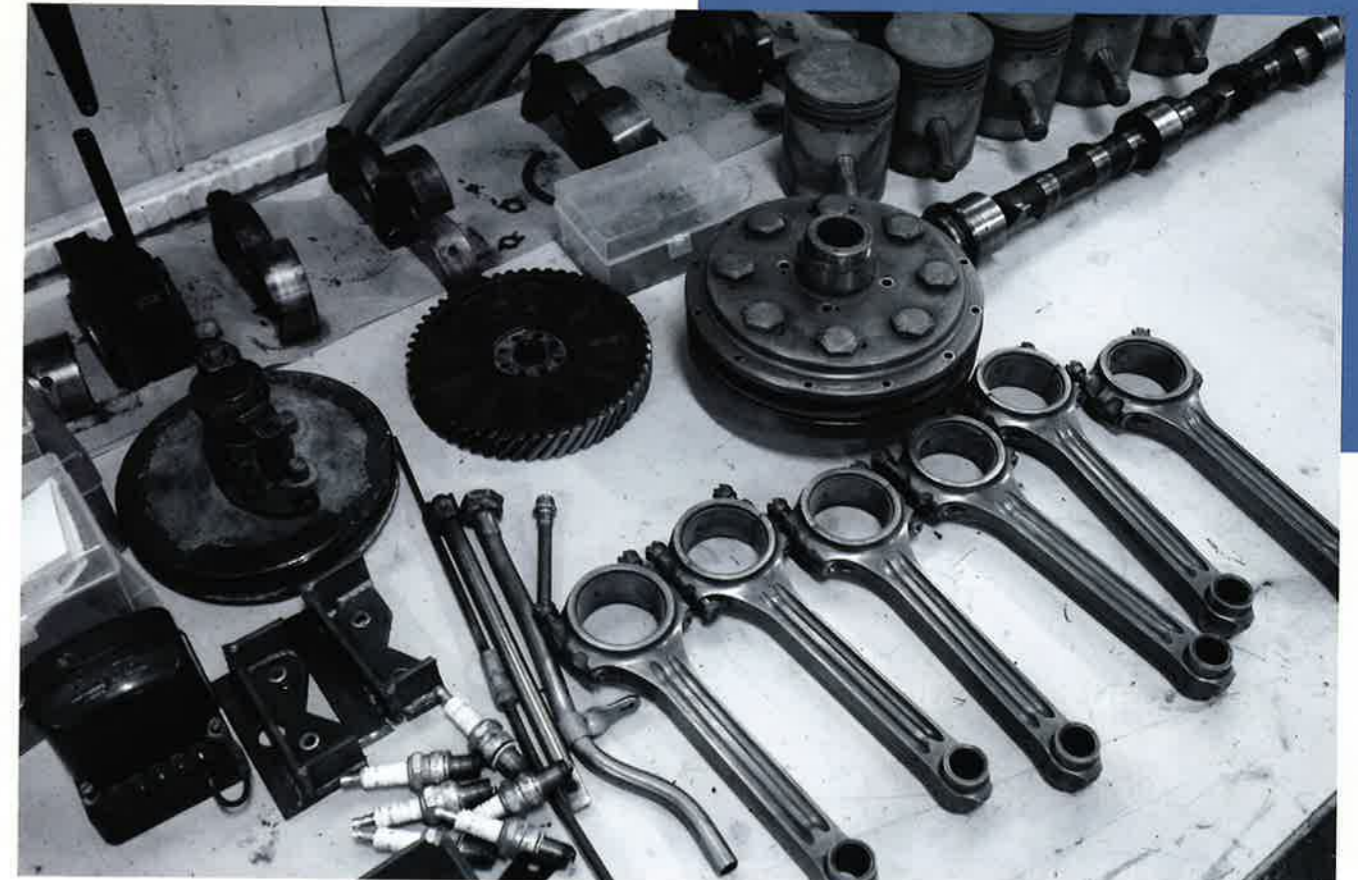

The timber to the inside of the car, dashboard, window veneers have all been replaced and the present woodwork to the interior of the car is identical to the original veneers.

The engine was completely dismantled, cleaned and adjusted with all worn parts were renewed. It is now back in and car running in perfect silence. The bodywork in aluminium was completely sand-blasted and primed to receive the many coats of Masons Black that gives it its deep lustre and elegance.
